Biblical References to God's Concern for the Life of Animals:

Most Christians proclaim Animals have no spirit or soul which only proves they should try reading the Book they preach from instead of preaching lies about what they don't understand and really don't know anything about, but want everyone to think they do. That's called 'Pride', and those proud of heart are an abomination to God Those are the ones who say they are proud of this or that, which means they 'Love themselves' for the accomplishments of others. Lies come from ONE source, the Devil/Satan, the Father of Lies and the Father of those doing the preaching, so preaching Lies in the name of God makes it the Gospel of the Devil (John 8:44).

The Greek word for Spirit>Pneuma: means Breath, Thought, Air and of course Spirit. It is said our Spirit/Soul resides in our Heart and expresses our desires through our mind in Thought to our tongue in Breath (Word) to the Air. Born into Human shells (tents) we are aliens in this world and learn to express our spirit in sounds and written symbols through this extremely high tech body and brain. All Breath is believed to return to God who gave it, says King Solomon, and all bodies return to the dust from which we all come from. Not just ourselves that receive and believe in the Spirit of Christ and in the name of Jesus, even those creatures with life not born of blood, nor of the will of flesh, nor of the will of man but the will of God, are invited to be children of God if we all but simply believe in Jesus or receive Him. That's why Jesus said to preach the Gospel to "All Creatures", even if you think they can't understand. I guess they can.

We may have been given dominion over all creatures and given permission to eat them but God requires our life blood in payment for their death and the blood of each creature that spills the blood of each creature. Tell me God doesn't care for the life of his critters. Even they will have to give an account for every drop of blood they spill of other creatures.

<u>Genesis 9:1-5</u> "And God blessed Noah and his sons and said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply, and fill the earth. 2 "And the fear of you and the terror of you shall be on every beast of the earth and on every bird of the sky; with everything that creeps on the ground, and all the fish of the sea, into your hand they are given. 3 "Every moving thing that is alive shall be food for you; I give all to you, as [I gave] the green plant. 4 "Only you shall not eat flesh with its life, [that is,] its blood. 5 "And surely I will require your lifeblood; from every beast I will require it. And from [every] man, from every man's brother I will require the life of man. (NASB)

<u>Psalms 74:19</u> Do not deliver the soul of Thy turtledove to the wild beast; Do not forget the life of Thine afflicted forever." (NASB)

Proverbs 12:10 A righteous man has regard for the life of his beast, But the compassion of the wicked is cruel. King Solomon (NASB)

Job 12:7 "But now ask the beasts, and let them teach you; And the birds of the heavens, and let them tell you. (NASB)

Job 35:11 Who teaches us more than the beasts of the earth, And makes us wiser than the birds of the heavens?' (NASB)

<u>Matthew 10:29-31</u> "Are not two sparrows sold for a cent? And [yet] not one of them will fall to the ground apart from your Father. 30 "But the very hairs of your head are all numbered. 31 "Therefore do not fear; you are of more value than many sparrows. (NASB)

<u>Luke 12:6-7</u> "Are not five sparrows sold for two cents? And [yet] not one of them is forgotten before God. 7 "Indeed, the very hairs of your head are all numbered. Do not fear; you are of more value than many sparrows. (NASB) <u>James 3:13-17</u> Who among you is wise and understanding? Let him show by his good behavior his deeds in the gentleness of wisdom. 14 But if you have bitter jealousy and selfish ambition in your heart, do not be arrogant and [so] lie against the truth. 15 This wisdom is not that which comes down from above, but is earthly, natural, demonic. 16 For where jealousy and selfish ambition exist, there is disorder and every evil thing. 17 But the wisdom from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, reasonable, full of mercy and good fruits, unwavering, without hypocrisy. (NASB)

<u>2Timothy 2:23-26</u> But refuse foolish and ignorant speculations, knowing that they produce quarrels. 24 And the Lord's bond-servant must not be quarrelsome, but be kind to all, able to teach, patient when wronged, 25 with gentleness correcting those who are in opposition, if perhaps God may grant them repentance leading to the knowledge of the truth, 26 and they may come to their senses [and escape] from the snare of the devil, having been held captive by him to do his will. (NASB)

Ecclesiastes 3:1-22 There is an appointed time for everything. And there is a time for every event under heaven-

- 2 A time to give birth, and a time to die; A time to plant, and a time to uproot what is planted.
- 3 A time to kill, and a time to heal; A time to tear down, and a time to build up.
- 4 A time to weep, and a time to laugh; A time to mourn, and a time to dance.
- 5 A time to throw stones, and a time to gather stones; A time to embrace, and a time to shun embracing.
- 6 A time to search, and a time to give up as lost; A time to keep, and a time to throw away.
- 7 A time to tear apart, and a time to sew together; A time to be silent, and a time to speak.
- 8 A time to love, and a time to hate; A time for war, and a time for peace.
- 9 What profit is there to the worker from that in which he toils?
- 10 I have seen the task which God has given the sons of men with which to occupy themselves.
- 11 He has made everything appropriate in its time. He has also set eternity in their heart, yet so that man will not find out the work which God has done from the beginning even to the end.
- 12 I know that there is nothing better for them than to rejoice and to do good in one's lifetime;
- 13 moreover, that every man who eats and drinks sees good in all his labor--it is the gift of God.
- 14 I know that everything God does will remain forever; there is nothing to add to it and there is nothing to take from it, for God has [so] worked that men should fear Him.
- 15 That which is has been already, and that which will be has already been, for God seeks what has passed by.
- 16 Furthermore, I have seen under the sun [that] in the place of justice there is wickedness, and in the place of righteousness there is wickedness.
- 17 I said to myself, "God will judge both the righteous man and the wicked man," for a time for every matter and for every deed is there.
- 18 I said to myself concerning the sons of men, "God has surely tested them in order for them to see that they are but beasts."

19For the fate of the sons of men and the fate of beasts is the same. As one dies so dies the other; indeed, they all have the same breath and there is no advantage for man over beast, for all is vanity.

- 20 All go to the same place. All came from the dust and all return to the dust.
- 21 Who knows that the breath of man ascends upward and the breath of the beast descends downward to the earth??
- 22 And I have seen that nothing is better than that man should be happy in his activities, for that is his lot. For who will bring him to see what will occur after him King Solomon? (NASB)

John 1:12-13 But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become children of God, [even] to those who believe in His name, 13 who were born not of blood, nor of the will of the flesh, nor of the will of man, but of God. (NASB)

<u>Proverbs 16:6</u> By loving kindness and truth iniquity is atoned for, And by the fear of the LORD one keeps away from evil. (NASB)

<u>ICorinthians 13:1-13</u> If I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, but do not have love, I have become a noisy gong or a clanging cymbal.

2 And if I have [the gift of] prophecy, and know all mysteries and all knowledge; and if I have all faith, so as to remove mountains, but do not have love, I am nothing.

- 3 And if I give all my possessions to feed [the poor,] and if I deliver my body to be burned, but do not have love, it profits me nothing.
- 4 Love is patient, love is kind, [and] is not jealous; love does not brag [and] is not arrogant,
- 5 does not act unbecomingly; it does not seek its own, is not provoked, does not take into account a wrong [suffered,] 6 does not rejoice in unrighteousness, but rejoices with the truth;
- 7 bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things.
- 8 Love never fails; but if [there are gifts of] prophecy, they will be done away; if [there are] tongues, they will cease; if [there is] knowledge, it will be done away.
- 9 For we know in part, and we prophesy in part;
- 10 but when the perfect comes, the partial will be done away.
- 11When I was a child, I used to speak as a child, think as a child, reason as a child; when I became a man, I did away with childish things.
- 12 For now we see in a mirror dimly, but then face to face; now I know in part, but then I shall know fully just as I also have been fully known.
- 13 But now abide faith, hope, love, these three; but the greatest of these is love. (NASB)

There is much more to understanding the Truth of Scriptures that takes time to grasp and study.
