## **Imaging: (IF NEEDED, MAY NOT BE NECESSARY)**

**CT scan**- Roughly \$1000.00 (includes the sedation or anesthesia and IS needed if receiving radiation therapy. We always have to repeat the CT if your pet had one done at your rDVM already because we position the patient for CT in a bite block that we use in the radiation therapy. The more conformal the plan the more important it is to get them back in the same position every time.)

Chest Radiographs- \$180.00-\$250.00

Abdominal Ultrasound-\$400.00

# **Radiation Therapy**

5 or fewer radiation therapy treatments @ \$230.00 PER treatment

6 or more radiation therapy treatments @ \$160.00 PER treatment

½ body radiation therapy @ roughly \$500.00 PER treatment

\$200.00-\$300.00 radiation therapy treatment planning fee (Dr.'s time in planning out the treatment)

Boarding (only for radiation therapy) \$40.00 a day

Patients are sedated with each radiation therapy treatment and we do not do treatments on the weekends or Holidays.

# **IV Chemotherapy & Electro chemotherapy:**

Based on the protocol and chemo drug, for each session it runs between \$200.00-\$400.00 A SESSION

These are basic procedures and just a guideline of what we do prior to treatment planning, but they MAY NOT need to be done at the appointment. It usually goes based on how recent staging was done with your pets Veterinarian or if you decide you would like to pursue further with treatment. It's always up to the Dr. if they feel further/recent diagnostics or imaging is needed.

This is a guide for you to know what to potentially be prepared for with cost.

Please note that this is not an estimate of exact charges since we have not seen your pet and all of these diagnostics and imaging may not be necessary. We CANNOT get a definitive cost until the day of the consult. But these are our standard costs for everything.
